At a meeting of the congregation of the first Reformed Dutch Church of the city and vicinity of Philadelphia held in the consistory chamber of said church on the afternoon of November. 10. 1823 when Frederick Gaul was appointed chairman and Joseph H Schreiner Secretary

Among other resolutions the following was adopted.

Resolved That the trustees be authorized to dispose of fifty four feet of the remaining front on Cherry Street) which will leave an entrance of seven feet into the burial ground for the best price that can be obtained.

At a meeting of the Trustees held May 21. 1824 a written application was read requesting to know the lowest price for two lots on Cherry Street 18 feet front each by 54 or 55 feet deep and on Motion Resolved That the lowest price for said lots be \$1100. and that the President and Secretary be authorized to make title of and convey the said lots in case of a sale and to use the corporate seal in executing the deed.
